

We congratulate 37 of our 40 **5 havo BEC** students on passing their **BEC Vantage exam** this year at the B2 level aimed at. (1 achieving B1; 2 absentees)

Four of our students (10%) passed within the C1 level of the CERF (Common European Framework of Reference for language – see picture) with a Grade A.

This year, five students got top marks (190 points) for Listening; two of those for Speaking as well; one for Speaking only; and one for Reading, Listening and Speaking. Well done!

Thirteen  $(32\frac{1}{2} \%)$  passed at B2 level (higher end – grade B) end 20 (50%) passed at the lower end (grade C) of the B2 level – congrats to all here too.

And one (2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> %) student received a B1 level.

Taken altogether, this counts as a  $92\frac{1}{2}$  % success rate for this exam.

It's only fair to say that all these students deserve an extra congratulatory compliment this year because of the challenging circumstances under which they had to prepare themselves for this exam.

And, finally, all the best in your Dutch national exams coming up soon.
